Procedure for access and booking of the Playing field and Batting Cages

In line with the Queensland Health COVID-19 Restrictions, Pine Hills will be adopting the following procedures for anyone wanting to use the Pine Hills Batting Cages or Field/s.

**As the Queensland Government eases restrictions, this procedure will be updated.

For BOTH Batting Cages and Field usage:

- You need to bring your own equipment including balls. The club will not be able to supply balls for any sessions.
- When you book the batting cages or field with Glassy, EVERY PERSON attending needs to be recorded and names given to Glassy.
- 15 mins break between different bookings to allow people to leave and arrive.
- Every person using the batting cages and field MUST have the Covid Safe App installed and proof of the app provided to Glassy when booking the field.
- Ensure you maintain personal hygiene practices of washing/sanitising hands immediately before and after using these facilities.
- All bookings are to be through phlbcfieldbooking@gmail.com

For the Batting Cages ONLY:

- Maximum of 6 people in the whole batting cages (2 per lane)

For Field Hire Only:

- Maximum of 20 people at a time on the WHOLE PLAYING field

New App to book the Batting Cages

Due to changes made by Master Lock (the company who produce the locks) there is a new App that will be used for any Batting cage bookings. The old app cannot be used anymore.
